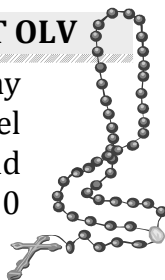
## SOCIAL CONCERNS SOME So Others Might Eat (Some)

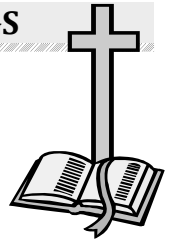
